Greetings from Loyola International School!

We would like to inform you about the Annual Examination Schedule for the below core and graded subjects and a few guidelines which are to be followed:

Graded subjects:

- Computer Science
- General Knowledge (Grade1 to 8)
- Qatar History
- Moral Science/Islamic Studies

Core subjects

- English
- Mathematics
- Science/EVS
- Social Studies (Grade 3 to 8)
- Second language
- Third language (Grade 4 to 8)

For Graded subjects Examination

- The Examinations for the above Graded subjects will be conducted between 28/02/2022 and 03/03/2022 during school hours. The duration of each Examination is 40 minutes, and each subject carries 25 marks.
- For grades 1 to 3, The first period will be conducted as per the regular timetable and examinations will be held between 8.20 am to 9.00 am (2nd period). After examination, there will be regular classes (3rd period onwards).

 For grades 4 to 8, The first four periods will be conducted as per the regular timetable and examinations will be held between 10.50 am to 11.30 am (5th period). After examination, there will be regular classes (6 & 7 periods).

For Core subjects Examination:

- The Examinations for the above core subjects will be conducted between 06/03/2022 to 17/03/2022 during school hours. The duration of each Examination is 2 hours for grades 1& 2 (30 marks), 2.5 hours for grades 3, 4 & 5 (60marks), and 3 hours for grade 6, 7 & 8 (80marks).
- The annual examination for the core subject will be held between 8 am to 10 am for grades 1 & 2, from 8:00 am to 10.30 am for grades 3, 4 and 5 and 8 am to 11 am for grades 6, 7 & 8.
- The syllabus and schedule for the graded subjects and core subjects have already been uploaded on CMS for your reference.
- In case a student is not able to attend the Examination due to unavoidable circumstances, parents must inform/email the Class teacher/school authorities well in advance (at least 5 days before the examination).
- All non-exam days are preparatory holidays.

Note: Any changes to the On-campus schedules will be informed to all the parents as and when the Ministry of education and higher education (MOEHE) issues any further directives.
