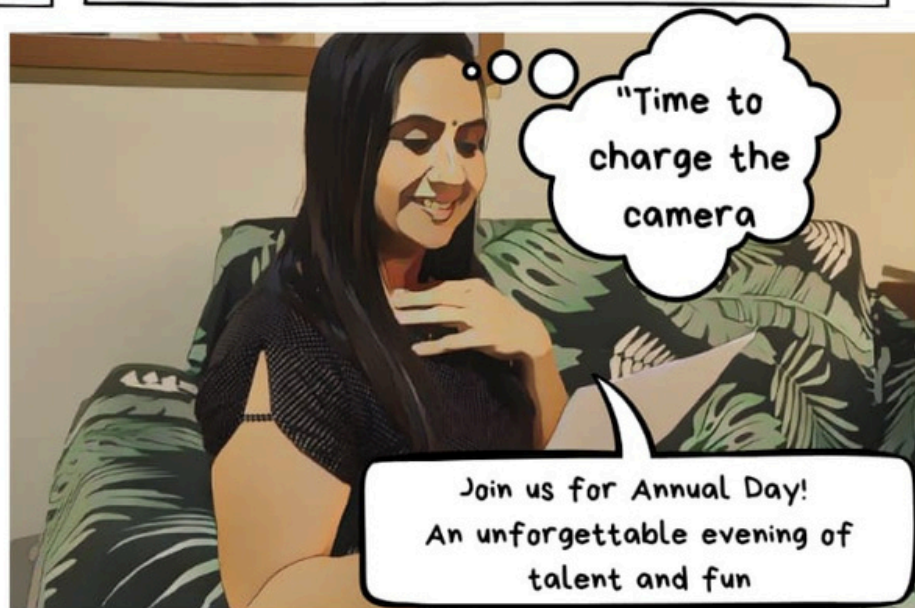
Student of the month is selected on various criteria like academic performance, participation in co-curricular activities, personal hygiene, behavioural discipline, regularity and uniform.

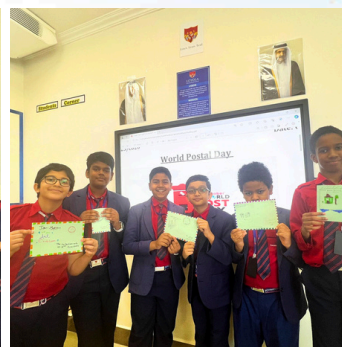
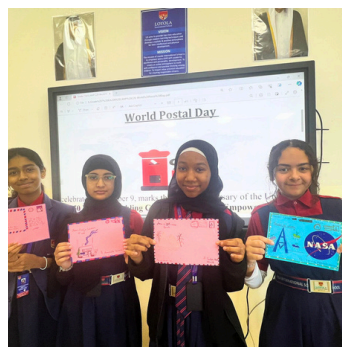
Activities building Personalities

Empathy Through Art: Our Kindergarteners Learn About Anti-Bullying

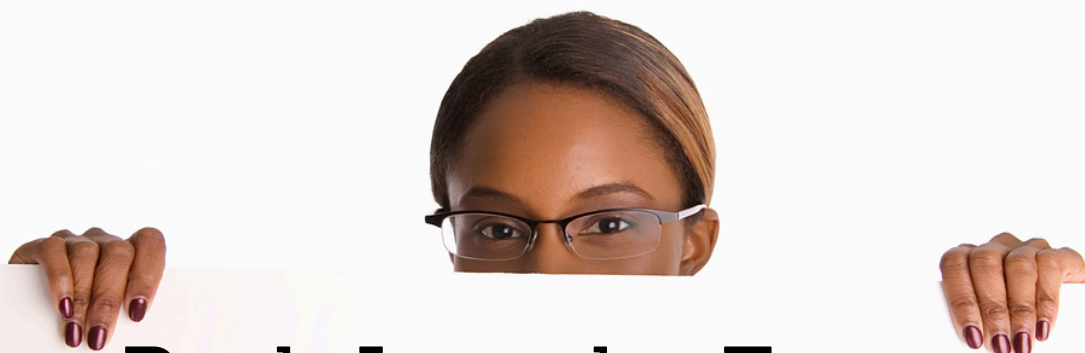
