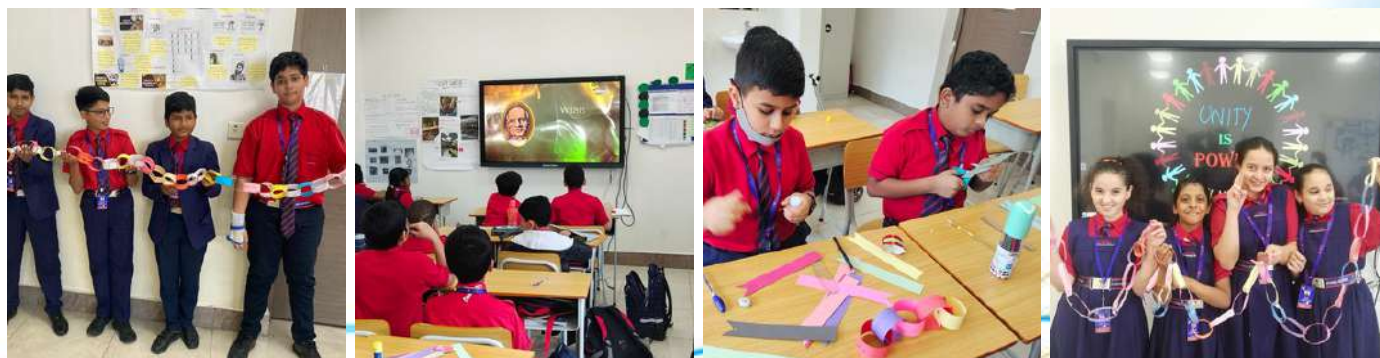
Computer Week (10-16 Oct 2023)

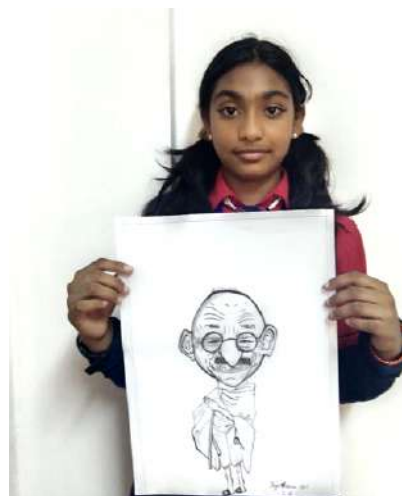
