

- **Don't Leave Your Project Unattended** It's your responsibility to be there!
- **Don't Ignore Questions:** Be prepared to answer queries and clarify doubts.
- Avoid Clutter: Keep your presentation area clean and organized.
- **Don't Be Distracted:** Stay focused and engaged during your presentation.
- **Don't Touch Other Projects Without Permission** Always ask first.
- **Don't Interrupt Others:** Wait for your turn to present and listen respectfully to others.
- Avoid Eating or Drinking at the Display Area: Keep the space clean and professional.
