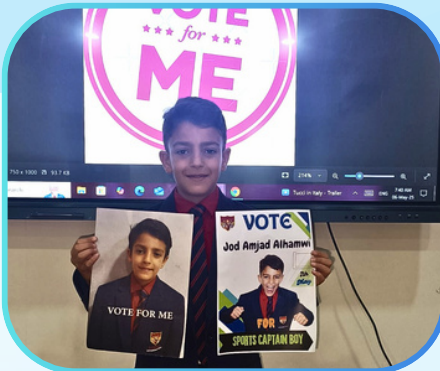

Loyola students honoured those who care for our school with consistency and heart.

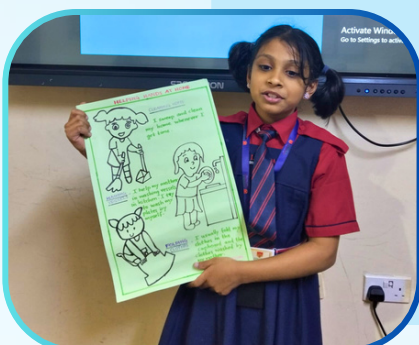
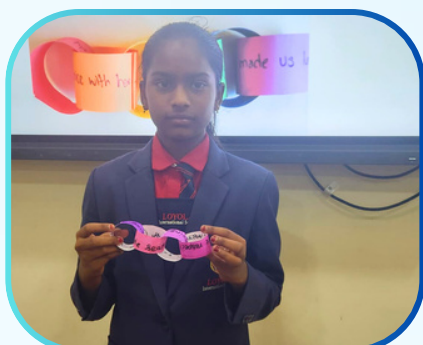
From felicitating our nurse and support staff to role-playing doctors, chefs, and cleaners — the day was full of thoughtful appreciation.
