# <u>CIRCULAR FOR PARENTS OF GRADES 3-5 – To prepare future ready students as per</u> new Competency based education by CBSE

Dear Parents,

#### Greetings!

This circular is to inform you about an important update to the academic assessment process for students of Grades 3–5. While students in these grades do not have a formal Periodic Assessment 1 (PA1), we understand the concerns raised by parents regarding continuous academic tracking and structured feedback.

In response, and in alignment with the evolving CBSE Competency-Based Education system, we are introducing Multiple Assessment as part of Term 1 for Grades 3–5.

## **Introduction of Monday Multiple Assessments:**

These Monday assessments will be distinct from the traditional question-answer format and will primarily focus on evaluating your child's understanding and application of concepts, in line with the principles of competency-based education. Furthermore, **Class Evaluations**, encompassing activities such as recitation, essay writing, projects, and other subject-specific tasks during regular class periods, will continue to be an integral part of their overall assessment.

## Competency-Based Assessment (CBA): A Step Towards the Future

The CBSE assessment system is progressively moving towards competency-based education. Our endeavor in introducing these Monday Multiple Assessments is to proactively prepare our students for this evolving landscape. These assessments are designed to:
